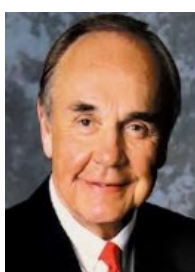

I'm honored – and embarrassed. The San Diego Tennis Hall of Fame has chosen six new honorees for induction, and I'm one of them.

How in the world can I report this to you in the pages of *ATR* without sounding like I'm shamelessly blowing my own trumpet? That's why you have my permission to hit the Escape button at any time.

The honorees will appear for induction at 4 p.m. October 1, 2022 at Morley Field's Balboa Tennis Club. Dress is casual. Admission is free.

They are Allison Bradshaw DeNike, a top junior and college player who competed professionally at the world level; Dick Enberg, the deceased international sports broadcaster who reported memorably from the four most important Grand Slams; Lornie Kuhle, a top tour-level coach (Jimmy Connors) and USTA tournament leader; Amber Liu, a top junior and college player; Todd Nelson, an ATP tour competitor and leading teaching professional, and John Martin, a retired newspaper and network television news correspondent who covered the four top Grand Slam championships numerous times.

The Hall was created in 2005-2006 by Larry Belinsky, who played Aztec men's tennis in 1973-76.. Including this year's honorees, the Hall celebrates 66 men and women.
